Despite only three points being between the sides at half time the game should really have been put to bed early on as numerous goal chances and wayward shooting from Moynalvey in the opening period left the home side still in the game at half time. Inside the third quarter both sides traded 0-3 apiece, with Moynalvey's scores coming from Brian Conneely, David Donoghue and James Weldon, while Kilminaham's scores came from Fergal Black, Mark Newman and Gerard Morgan, leaving the three points between the sides, 1-9 to 1-6, midway through the second half. The final quarter proved fruitless for the home side as they were to trouble the score board no more, while Moynalvey added a further 1-4 to their tally, leaving them 10 point winners on a 2-13 to 1-6 score line.
