It was the Blacks who got off to the better start opening up a three point lead after five minutes. The sides were level after nine minutes when Shane Lenehan grabbed Moynalvey's first score of the game, turning his man 25 yards from the posts and surging forward to blast to the back of Ciaran Lyden's net. Five minutes later Moynalvey took the lead for the first time when Cathal Sheridan expertly fired over a '45.
