Whilst the final scoreboard might show an emphatic Moynalvey victory, this game was far from easy as local rivals Summerhill put it up to the men in maroon for 40 minutes of this game before fading in the final quarter.

Summerhill started brightly hitting the Moynalvey crossbar in the first minute before Moynalvey settled and points by Mark O'Sullivan, Cathal Sheridan and PJ Walsh had Moynalvey 0-3 to 00 ahead after 15 minutes. Further points from Sheridan and John Donoghue accompanied by a Sheridan goal after a well worked move had Moynalvey 1-5 to 0-2 ahead at the interval.
