

Moynalvey overcame a 5 point half time deficit to ensure they gained a valuable point in this intermediate championship group B game played under lights in Pairc Tailteann on Tuesday night 15th September.

Moynalvey were slow out of the stalls as Kilmainhamwood raced into a 5 point lead within 8 minutes after registering a goal and two points. Moynalvey tagged on a further 3 points through frees from the accurate boot of Sheridan to leave just a point between the sides with only 5 minutes of the half remaining. However they missed the chance to go ahead, when a superb ball in from Sheridan resulted in David Donoghue being fouled in the area, only for Sheridan to send the resulting penalty wide of the target. Kilmainhamwood then hit Moynalvey with a sucker punch when after tagging on another point, put themselves 5 points to the good just before the interval when finding the net for a second time.
