

Moynalvey's second string suffered a heavy defeat at the hands of St. Colmcilles on Tuesday evening June 4<sup>th</sup> at Curraha in the third round of the Junior 'B' Championship.

### ***St. Colmcilles 3-14 Moynalvey 1-9***

The first quarter of this contest was a keenly fought affair with St. Colmcilles just shading matters leading 0-6 to 0-3 after 14 minutes of play, with Moynalvey's points coming from David Durkan, Cathal McCabe and Ciaran Collins.
