As it was at the break, the majority of the second period was a two point game with just two points between the sides with two minutes remaining. The loss of Harnan proved to be a major loss to the Moynalvey forward line as they had to work harder for scores in comparison to their opponents. No more than two points separated the sides at any time in the second period up until the 58th minute, when the Moynalvey rearguard was left exposed as they pushed forward in search of scores and Ratoath took full advantage, when the ball was worked forward to their full forward to blast to the back of the Moynalvey net past 'keeper Ollie Regan, giving the host side a five point winning margin on a 2-13 to 1-11 score line and securing the two points on offer.
